# Gift Aid your gift

## The benefits of Gift Aid

Since April 2000, the Gift Aid Scheme has been simplified and the £250 threshold has been removed. Today any donation you make over £1.00 is worth an extra 28% to Birmingham Dogs' Home. If tax has been levied on your income at the time you earned it (and this includes payments into a pension) then Birmingham Dogs' Home can claim back the tax on your one-off or regular gift at no extra cost to yourself.

To make a Gift Aid donation either as a single or regular gift, simply complete the Gift Aid Declaration Form below and send it together with your gift to Birmingham Dogs' Home, New Bartholomew Street, Digbeth, Birmingham B5 5QS. # Making a Legacy

## Remembering Birmingham Dogs' Home

Legacies are very important to the home and provide the majority of our funds.

When making a legacy to Birmingham Dogs' Home, you can do so in confidence that sensitive and appropriate stewardship of your gift is of paramount importance to us.

Birmingham Dogs' Home strongly recommends that you seek professional legal advice when writing your Will, or adding a Codicil, if you have already made a Will. If you decide to make a legacy to Birmingham Dogs' Home, your solicitor needs to be aware that if Birmingham Dogs' Home is to benefit, then the exact wording in the following statement must be used in your Will or Codicil:

"I bequeath to the Birmingham Dogs' Home, the sum of .. (for general purposes) (for the purpose of ...)

When discussing your Will or Codicil with your solicitor, you may find it helpful to know that there are various types of legacy from which to choose:

**The Pecuniary Legacy:** The pecuniary or monetary legacy enables you to donate a specific amount of money to a named individual or organisation. Provision should be made for index-linking the legacy, so that the value of the gift does not decrease with inflation.

**The Residual Legacy:** The residual legacy involves leaving all or part of the net residue of your estate to a named individual or organisation once all pecuniary legacies, debts and other liabilities have been met. **The Reversionary Legacy** is another popular type of legacy that enables you to provide for your loved ones first and benefit the Birmingham Dogs' Home, for example afterwards. A reversionary legacy involves leaving your assets to trustees so beneficiaries can enjoy the income during their lifetime, with the whole or part reverting to the Birmingham Dogs' Home on their death.

**The Specific or Non-pecuniary Legacy:** This type of legacy allows you to leave a specific personal possession to the Birmingham Dogs' Home, for example property, stocks and shares, works of art, or other valuables.
